

Partnership Deed

1. Name and Business

Any changes in the constitution of the Firm due to admission, retirement, or death of a Partner shall be made by executing a supplementary deed.

10. Dissolution

The Firm may be dissolved at any time by mutual consent of the Partners and all assets and liabilities will be settled according to law.

11. Miscellaneous

Any matters not provided for in this Deed shall be governed by the provisions of the Indian Partnership Act, 1932 or any amendments thereto.
