

Main Objects Clause in Memorandum of Association

1. Main Objects

1. To carry on the business of manufacturing, processing, buying, selling, exporting, importing, and trading in all kinds of goods, merchandise, and commodities, whether finished, semi-finished, raw or processed, including but not limited to machinery, equipment, consumer goods, and industrial products.
2. To act as agents, distributors, representatives, and stockists for any company, firm, or person in connection with any business described above.
3. To undertake, either alone or in partnership with others, any contracts, works, or assignments related to the business of the company as described in objects (1) and (2) above.

2. Ancillary Objects

1. To acquire, purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise hold, develop, or deal in any movable or immovable property, rights, privileges, or licenses necessary or convenient for the company's objectives.
2. To borrow, raise or secure payment of money for the purposes of the company in such manner as may be deemed fit.
3. To undertake and execute any trust, the undertaking of which may seem beneficial to the company's business.

3. Other Objects

1. To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
