

Kindergarten Lesson Plan

Lesson Title	Exploring Shapes Around Us
Grade Level	Kindergarten
Subject	Mathematics
Duration	30 minutes

Standards

- **CCSS.MATH.CONTENT.K.G.A.2:** Correctly name shapes regardless of their orientations or overall size.

Learning Objectives

- Students will identify and name basic shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle).
- Students will find examples of shapes in their classroom environment.

Materials Needed

- Shape cut-outs
- Chart paper and markers
- Pencils and crayons
- Pictures of real-world objects

Lesson Procedure

Introduction (5 min)

- Begin by asking students if they can name any shapes they already know.
- Show shape cut-outs and introduce their names: circle, square, triangle, rectangle.

Guided Practice (10 min)

- Hold up pictures of real-world objects (e.g., clock, book, slice of pizza) and have students name the shapes they see.
- Place shape cut-outs around the room and let students find and name them.

Independent Practice (10 min)

- Give students a worksheet to draw and color objects that match each shape.
- Ask students to share an object in the classroom that matches a shape.

Closure (5 min)

- Review shape names as a class.
- Ask students to name one shape they learned today.

Assessment

- Observation during activity and participation in class discussions.
- Completed worksheet matching objects to shapes.

Differentiation

- Provide extra support or practice for students who need it.
- Challenge advanced students to find more than one example for each shape.

Reflection

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
