

English as a Second Language Lesson Structure Example

1. Warm Up

Brief activity or discussion to engage students and introduce the topic.

- Greetings and small talk
- Short game or question related to the topic

2. Presentation

Introduce new vocabulary, grammar, or concepts using clear examples.

- Use visuals, gestures, or realia
- Model sentences or dialogues

3. Practice

Students practice new language in controlled activities.

- Fill-in-the-blank exercises
- Pair or group drills
- Repetition and substitution

4. Production

Students use new language freely in speaking or writing activities.

- Role-plays or dialogues
- Short presentations or compositions

5. Review & Feedback

Review key points and give feedback on performance.

- Check understanding with questions
- Highlight common mistakes
- Summarize the lesson

6. Homework / Extension

Assign brief tasks to reinforce learning outside the classroom.

- Workbook exercises
- Short writing assignments
- Practice dialogues at home
