

Data Collection Policy

For Location-Based Mobile Applications

This Data Collection Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect information collected through our location-based mobile application ("the App").

1. Information We Collect

- **Location Data:** We collect your device's geographic location when the App is in use and, with permission, in the background.
- **Device Information:** We may collect device-specific information such as model, operating system, and unique identifiers.
- **Usage Data:** We collect information about your interactions with the App, such as features used and duration of use.
- **Account Information:** If you register an account, we collect your email, username, and any additional profile information you provide.

2. How We Use Your Information

- To provide location-based features and services.
- To improve and personalize user experience.
- To communicate updates and important information to users.
- For analytics and internal reporting purposes.
- To comply with legal obligations and respond to law enforcement requests, if required.

3. Information Sharing

- We do not sell your personal information to third parties.
- We may share limited data with service providers who assist us in operating the App, under confidentiality agreements.
- We may share information if required by law or to protect rights, property, or safety.

4. Data Security

We implement reasonable security measures to protect your data against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction.

5. User Control

- You may choose to enable or disable location services via your device settings at any time.
- You may request to review, update, or delete your account information by contacting us.

6. Changes to this Policy

We may update this Data Collection Policy periodically. We will notify users of any material changes through the App

or by other means.
