

# Home Automation Hub

## User Documentation

### Overview

The Home Automation Hub (HAH) enables users to control, automate, and monitor smart devices throughout the home, using a web interface accessible from any device on the local network.

### Getting Started

1. Plug in your HAH device and connect it to your Wi-Fi network following the initial setup guide included in your box.
2. Access the HAH interface by navigating to `http://homehub.local` in your web browser.
3. Create a user account and sign in to begin configuring your devices.

### Adding New Devices

1. From the main dashboard, go to **Devices > Add Device**.
2. Select the device type (e.g., Smart Light, Thermostat).
3. Follow on-screen instructions to pair the device with the hub.
4. Name your device and assign it to a room.

### Common Features

Feature	Description	Location
Device Control	On/Off, scheduling, grouping	Dashboard
Scenes	Activate multiple devices with a single tap	Scenes tab
Automation	Set triggers & actions	Automation tab
Notifications	Receive status or safety alerts	Settings > Notifications

### Automation Example

```
If motion detected in "Hallway" after 9 PM:  
  - Turn on Hallway Light  
  - Send notification to Mobile
```

### Troubleshooting

- If a device is not responding, try removing and re-adding it.
- Ensure your hub and devices are on the same network.
- Restart the hub if you experience connectivity issues.
