

Security and Privacy Compliance Guidelines

1. Introduction

This document outlines the key security and privacy compliance guidelines to ensure the protection and responsible management of sensitive information within the organization. - Report security incidents or breaches promptly to the compliance team.
- Maintain documentation demonstrating compliance with relevant laws and policies.
