

Smart Thermostat Installation Guide Template

1. Overview

This guide provides general steps and recommendations to install a smart thermostat in your home. Follow the instructions and safety precautions for a successful installation.

2. Tools & Materials Needed

- Screwdriver (Philips/Flathead)
- Drill (if mounting requires)
- Smart thermostat device & mounting hardware
- Phone or tablet with thermostat app
- Main power supply access
- Level (optional)

3. Safety Precautions

- Turn off power to your HVAC system at the breaker box before starting.
- Verify power is off before touching wiring.
- Refer to your thermostat and HVAC manuals for additional safety guidelines.

4. Installation Steps

1. Remove the existing thermostat cover and take a photo of the wiring for reference.
2. Label the wires using the supplied labels.
3. Disconnect and remove the old thermostat.
4. Attach the new mounting plate and connect the wires to the correct terminals.
5. Secure the smart thermostat to the plate.
6. Restore power and follow the on-screen setup instructions.
7. Complete configuration via the thermostat app on your phone or tablet.

5. Common Wiring Reference

Wire Label	Function
R / RC / RH	Power
C	Common (for smart thermostats)
W	Heating
Y	Cooling
G	Fan
O/B	Heat Pump (Changeover Valve)

6. Troubleshooting

- Thermostat doesn't power on: Check power, correct wiring, and ensure 'C' wire is connected if needed.

- No response from HVAC system: Verify correct wiring and that breakers are on.
- Wi-Fi connection issues: Ensure router is functioning and restart the thermostat.
