

# Non-Disclosure Clause Example for Employment

## Non-Disclosure of Confidential Information

The Employee acknowledges that during the course of employment, they may acquire confidential and proprietary information relating to the business, clients, operations, or trade secrets of the Employer ("Confidential Information"), whether oral, written, electronic, or other form.

The Employee agrees that, both during and after the term of employment, they shall not, directly or indirectly, disclose, use, or cause to be disclosed any Confidential Information to any third party without the prior written consent of the Employer, except when required by law or as necessary in the ordinary course of performing their employment duties.

Upon termination of employment, the Employee agrees to promptly return, delete, or destroy all materials and documents containing Confidential Information, including any copies made, as directed by the Employer.

This clause shall remain in effect during and after the Employee's employment, for as long as the information remains confidential.
