Fire Hazards & Prevention

- Keep work areas clean and free of clutter
- Do not block fire exits, alarm pull stations, or extinguishers
- Store flammables in designated, ventilated areas
- Follow proper procedures when using electrical equipment
- Report damaged wires or faulty equipment immediately

Emergency Procedures

1. Activate the nearest fire alarm if fire or smoke is detected
2. Evacuate the area using posted escape routes
3. Do not use elevators during a fire emergency
4. Close doors behind you as you leave
5. Report to the designated assembly area
6. Do not re-enter the building until given the all-clear

Fire Extinguisher Use (PASS)

- Pull the pin
- Aim at the base of the fire
- Squeeze the handle
- Sweep from side to side
