

# Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

## Bulk Packaging and Palletizing

### 1. Purpose

To ensure consistent quality and efficiency in the bulk packaging and palletizing process.

### 2. Scope

This SOP applies to all staff involved in the packaging and palletizing of bulk goods in the production area.

### 3. Responsibilities

- Operators: Execute bulk packaging and palletizing as per guidelines.
- Supervisors: Oversee operations and ensure compliance with this SOP.
- Quality Control: Inspect packaging and palletized goods for compliance.

### 4. Equipment & Materials

- Bulk packaging materials (bags, sacks, boxes, shrink wrap, etc.)
- Packaging machines
- Pallets (wood or plastic)
- Pallet jack or forklift
- Strapping tools
- Labels and markers
- PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

### 5. Procedure

#### 1. Preparation

- Check cleanliness and readiness of packaging area and equipment.
- Verify material and packaging against order specifications.
- Wear appropriate PPE.

#### 2. Bulk Packaging

- Inspect packaging materials for damage.
- Set up packaging machine with required settings.
- Fill product into packaging up to specified weight/volume.
- Seal packaging securely.
- Apply labels with date, batch/lot, and product information.

#### 3. Palletizing

- Inspect pallets for cleanliness and damage.
- Stack packaged goods in accordance with layout (see table below for sample pattern).
- Ensure weight is distributed evenly and stacks are stable.

- Secure the entire load using stretch wrap and strapping as needed.
- Label pallet with identification and handling instructions.

4. **Post-Operation**

- Clean and store equipment.
- Document finished pallets in inventory records.
- Report any incidents or discrepancies to supervisor.

6. Sample Palletizing Pattern

Layer	Number of Packages	Stack Arrangement
1	10	Horizontal
2	10	Vertical (cross-stack)
3	10	Horizontal
4	10	Vertical (cross-stack)

7. Documentation

- Bulk packaging batch records
- Pallet labels and inventory logs
- Inspection and incident reports (if any)

8. Safety & Precautions

- Ensure correct manual handling techniques to prevent injury.
- Inspect all packaging and palletizing tools before use.
- Use PPE at all times.
